UNESCO Office Beijing is extending financial contribution for organizing this training course under ISI of IHP-UNESCO.

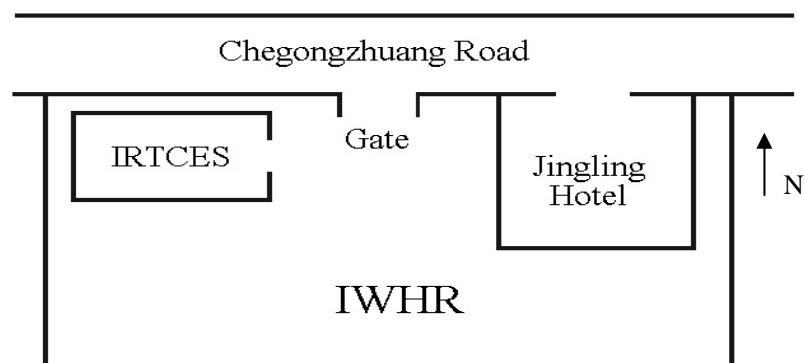

Currency Exchange

In China only RMB is used. Exchange can be made at all Banks. The rate of exchange is set by the Bank of China, which is about US\$1.00=RMB ¥ 6.80Yuan, and EUR€1.00=RMB ¥ 9.70Yuan. When exchanging money, please keep your receipt by which you can change any residual RMB back to foreign currency when leaving China.

Local Transportation

It is available and easy to call TAXI in front of IWHR (IRTCS Building is located within IWHR). The initial fare is 10 yuan (RMB) for 3 km maximum, 2 yuan added per km followed. The public bus is also very convenient and cheaper, only almost one yuan per time.

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
